Declarations of Interest

Minutes

Grants process / criteria

Following the last meeting of the Committee, Officers revised the grant application process in line with the recommendations of the Committee. Key changes made as follows:

- The Committee agreed the new checklist document for applicants

- The Committee agreed the existing grant appraisal form (for Members to complete)
- The Committee agreed two windows for applications per annum will suffice, with the first closing at end of April, and the second closing at the end of October each year
- The Committee approved funding for two workshops per year to help support local organisations with their grant application.

Members considered the proposed changes and voted unanimously to accept.

It was also agreed to recommend a £10,000.00 threshold for the committee to Full Council.

D-Day Event - 6 June 2024

The Chief Officer gave Members an update on the proposed event to mark the anniversary of the D-Day landings. Officers will draw up an event plan for the day with an agreed budget of £2500.00 (delegated to the officers to facilitate the event).

Community Equipment

Members were provided with a list of indicative costs to purchase 'community assets' which could be used by organisers of local events and festivals. It was noted that the Council does not currently have the facility to accommodate all of the items, but that there is some limited space available for some of the items if the Committee wish to pursue further investigation.

Members voted to approve the purchase of a PA system at a cost of £12,500.00. Delegated to Officers to secure best value.
