- 1. **Apologies** to receive apologies for absence.
- 2. **Declarations of Interests** to note declarations of members' interests.
- 3. **Minutes** to consider the minutes of the last meeting.
- 4. Vice Chairman to duly elect a Vice Chairman.
- 5. Public Participation to adjourn the meeting for a period of public discussion.
- 6. **Noticeboards** to consider the report and agree which style and type of noticeboard the Committee would prefer officers to pursue. Noting the budget for this expenditure would be incurred within the 'public realm enhancements' (£50K) or 'environment contingency' (£16.5K) budget.
- 7. **Community Skip Scheme** to receive a verbal update and note this item will be brought back to a future meeting.
- 8. **Foamstream** to note that a demonstration of Foamstream took place and receive a verbal report on its outcome.
- 9. Land Parcels at its meeting held on 21.9.23, the Council confirmed it was still keen to pursue transforming small parcels of land for local communities, and it resolved to focus on two areas of land in the first instance (Maylands Square and Mardale Avenue), agreeing to undertake additional community consultation to develop a more detailed proposal and management plan to submit to Lancaster City Council. As such, the Committee is asked to consider the drafted survey.
- 10. **Allotments** to note that additional site visits and meetings have been undertaken with the Allotment Association regarding the way in which the two organisations can work together in the future. To consider the report and agree for communication to remain ongoing.
- 11. Climate Action Champion in light of the Town Council's Climate Emergency declaration, the Council's hasn't yet actively pursued a specific 'green agenda', aside from making green choices when possible (for example, purchasing electric equipment). The Committee is asked to give consideration to recommending to full council the appointment of a 'Climate Action Champion' or similar, who could help steer the authority in a more environmentally friendly direction. This may tie into some of the initiatives of the Environment Committee, in particular the work some members have expressed an appetite to pursue in relation to clearing up the Bay and liaising with United Utilities to reduce the volume of raw sewage discharged into local watercourses.
- 12. **Spring Flower Beds** to consider the report and agree actions.
- 13. **Christmas Lights** to consider the report and agree actions.
